

- Commissionaires is accredited by the RCMP and recognized by local police departments and the Government of Canada. Commissionaires was one of only two civil agencies invited by the RCMP to participate in the start-up (2006 Pilot Project).
- RTID (Real Time Identification) is a National Police Services project designed to eliminate or reduce paper transactions for both criminal and civil fingerprint submissions.
- Commissionaires commenced full electronic civil transaction submissions in March 2007. Certification and the success of the initial RTID software pilot project were subsequently achieved.
- The Livescan system for digital fingerprinting used by Commissionaires comprises the following technical components:
  - RCMP-certified digital fingerprint scanner and laser printer
  - Laptop computer
  - Digital camera and tripod
  - Signature pad
  - RCMP-certified Unidac software - developed by Excellium our technical support partner
